Location: Approx. 80 miles NW of Laramie, WY

LEGAL DESCRIPTION: Part of Record of Survey #946683 on file at the Albany County Court house located in Laramie, WY.

ACRES: 37.9

ACCESS: A private road was constructed in the summer of 1999 that extends 5 1/2 miles from a county gravel road. The new road includes pit run gravel.

<u>TIMBER:</u> No timber on this property, all open grassland. Timber covered mountains are east and west of this property.

TOPOGRAPHY: Level to slightly rolling terrain, abundant building sites.

AVAILABLILTY OF WATER: Existing wells in this area run from 100 ft to 130 ft deep and produce an average flow of 7 1/2 gallons per minute, and that's a good volume. Generally the deeper you drill the softer the water will be. State permit is required.

ELEVATION: Approx. 6,900 APPROXIMATE ANNUAL TAXES (per parcel): \$120

<u>IMPROVEMENTS AND UTILTIES:</u> Power line is 5 1/2 miles to 6 1/2 miles NE of these parcels. Good cellular telephone coverage in this area.

<u>DISTANCE TO NEAREST TOWN:</u> Medicine Bow 20 miles SW <u>POPULATION:</u> Approx. 400 Laramie 50 miles SE Approx. 26,000

DESCRIPTION OF TOWN: Laramie is home to the University of Wyoming. We have found the people to be warm, friendly, and trusting. Medicine Bow is a much smaller town with very friendly people. Cheyenne the state capital is 60 miles the east of Laramie.

RECTEATION FACILITIES: Seminoe Reservoir is about 35 miles west, and the Pathfinder Reservoir is also about 35 miles to the west. Wheatland Reservoir #3 is only 15 miles southeast and has great fishing. There are many access sites with boat ramps and campgrounds around these reservoirs for your use.

<u>DEED AND TITLE CONDITION</u>: Warranty Deed, Insured Title, Guaranteed Access, all Mineral Rights owned by us pass with title, existing grazing lease with previous owner allows our buyers to fence out if desired.
